Hospice Update Fall 2022

Construction on the Hospice began in April and so much has happened at the site of Lionel Kelland Hospice! On the third level where residents' rooms are located, drywall is being installed. The central elevator shaft work is done and the exterior's stone facing has been fitted. The electrical and mechanical work are well underway. We are happy to report that construction is on schedule and that the Hospice is still on target to begin operations in late spring of 2023.

The Hospice will feature amenities that create a comfortable, nurturing environment, including a kitchen serving fresh, homemade meals, a living room, a sacred place, and space for family members to stay overnight. Serving people of all ages and cultural backgrounds, the Hospice will offer both residential and community outreach programs.

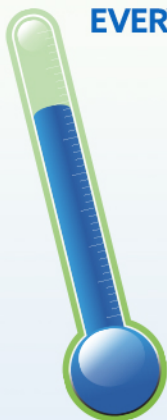
In addition to the construction progress, we have begun the recruitment process for an Executive Director for the Hospice and are aiming to have the position filled by December 2022.
